THE STATE'S BUSINESS-ORIENTED LEGISLATURE

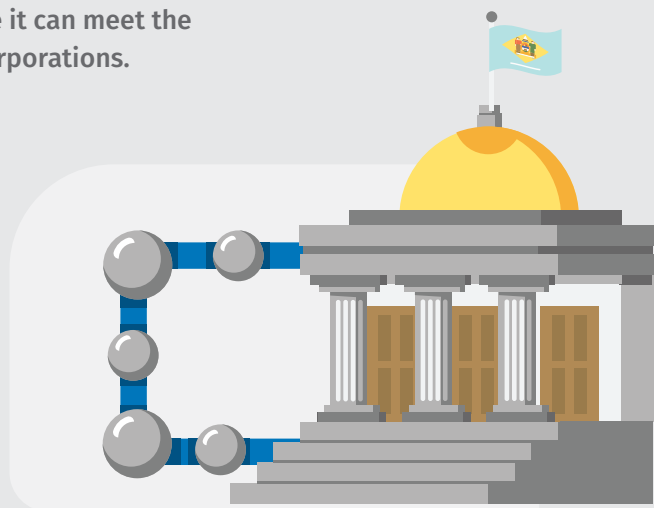
amends the General Corporation Law every year to ensure it can meet the needs of modern corporations.

THE CASE LAW

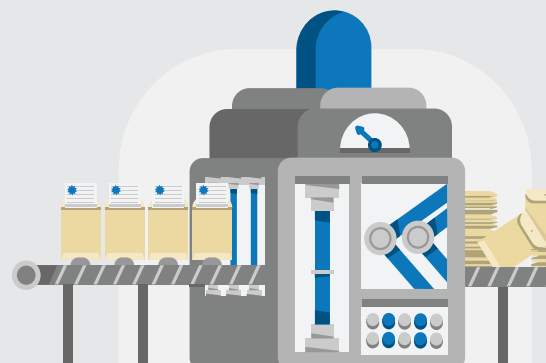
is the largest, most comprehensive, and most complete body of corporate case law in the country, which provides corporate officials and their legal counsel extensive precedents.
