# COUNTRY GUIDE

Once the epicenter of the Roman Empire and birthplace of the influential Renaissance movement, Italy is today among the top 10 largest nations by nominal GDP and the third-largest economy in the Eurozone. The country's strategic location, at the center of Europe, extending well into the Mediterranean Sea, has helped develop a long tradition of trading and profiting off its market economy and skilled workforce.



### **TOURISM**

Tourism is by far Italy's largest industry, accounting for about 11.8% of the country's total GDP. Fifty-one UNESCO World Heritage sites are located in Italy, the most of any country in the world.

#### STRATEGIC LOCATION AND EASE OF TRADE

The country's position along the Mediterranean Sea has enabled it to cultivate a vibrant trading industry especially with North Africa, Eastern Europe, and the Middle East. Italy is currently the eighth top exporter in the world and its main trading partners include Germany, the United States, Spain, the UK, Switzerland, and France. As a founding member of the European Union, Italy offers access to a wider market of approximately 500 million consumers.

#### **BANKING SECTOR**

Despite recent political turbulence, the Italian banking sector remains a strong point of the country's economy. The Italian government is continuing to take steps over the next few years to encourage the consolidation of banks through mergers, takeovers, asset transfers, liquidations, or the conversion of a bank into a financial company. Their goal is to boost the international competitiveness of the Italian banking sector.

### **AGRICULTURE**

While vineyards take up only 5.4% of Italy's agricultural land, it is the world's largest producer of wine, which includes the popular Piedmontese Barolo, Frascati, Barbaresco, and Tuscan Chianti. It is also a leading producer of tropical fruits such as oranges, kiwi, peaches, olives, plums, lemons, cherries, and apricots, in addition to thriving fishing and livestock sectors.
